

Job Description

A person with good communication skills, conflict resolution skills, who has an understanding of trauma, able to be trauma sensitive. This person should be able to manage the day-to-day operations of the house which includes but is not limited to; maintaining cooking & cleaning schedules, dispensing the medications for the residents.

We are looking for someone who has a mature relationship with the Lord with the ability to accept the residents in the home where they are at in their spiritual journey without judgement. The house staff should have a passion for walking along side women who have been trafficked and supportive of their respective process in their restoration. An understanding of trafficking is essential. An understanding of addictions is necessary as the majority of women in our program have chemical dependency issues they are working through. We will provide extensive training in all areas of trauma sensitivity, working with addictions etc.

Schedule would be for 4, 6, or 8-hour shifts. *Afternoons, 8pm-8am and weekends needed.* *Commitment to serve at least one year.
